Established in 1999, the FCC Long Island Chinese School has served adopted children and their families in developing a strong link to their Chinese Heritage. Organized completely by parent volunteers, the school has continued to grow with each year.

The focus of our program is Mandarin Language and Chinese culture, geared specifically for the needs of our community of families - - families who do not speak Mandarin at home, nor have extensive knowledge of Chinese culture. Our program is unique in that classes are held jointly for children and their parents who attend and participate together. As a result, our program fosters an environment that acts as a support group for both parents and children alike.

Language is taught first through songs, dance and games, and then as young children progress in their abilities, become used to a classroom setting, and further develop their fine motor skills, lessons continue to progress. Soon including character recognition first through reading, and then writing. Stroke order is taught through an innovative approach of cutting and piecing together characters. This technique was developed by our own Principal, Ms. Man-Li Lin and is now used by other schools across the US and in China. It has allowed even our youngest children to learn over 50 characters in a years time. Man-Li has written all of our textbooks.
