

**Subject: Join us in Celebrating the Year of the Ox**

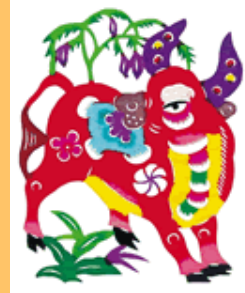
