Dear Families,

Youth Group is ready to start up again! We've got some great things planned for your kids and hope that those of you with children who have participated in the past, will continue to do so, and will help to welcome new members to our group at our first meeting.

It will be held on Saturday, October 24th at 6:30 pm at The Calvary Lutheran Church, 36 Taylor St. in East Meadow. It is a really comfortable venue for both parents and children to mingle and share our common bond of adoption. Youth Group is for children ages 8 and up. Get-togethers will be scheduled approximately every other month. We will post the date and activity/location planned for the first 3 meetings and hope you can make it to those that appeal to you, and can mark your calendars accordingly.

The theme of our 1st meeting, on Oct. 24th, will be GETTING TO KNOW EACH OTHER. We'll have some structured* activities planned so the kids can find out more about each other and help establish relationships. We ask that you bring the following to the meeting to help make this happen:

1. A couple of different color skeins of embroidery floss (thread) that we will share in making friendship bracelets. (In my experience boys enjoy making these also. If you are the parent of a boy, and don't think so, perhaps you can offer an alternative item they can make that they can exchange in the spirit of friendship?)
2. A writing notebook (spiral, marble...whatever) and pen/pencil. (*They'll also have some unstructured time to socialize.)

To make things easy, we will order a pizza and share in the cost of the pies/water/soda. If anyone is so inclined to bring drinks/cups, please feel free to do so, and advise when you RSVP for the meeting.

Please remember THIS IS NOT A DROP OFF EVENT!!!! No one person is in charge, and all parents are responsible for the supervision of their own child/ren. Please also realize that we are all expected to help in whatever way possible, including cleaning up and leaving the Church in the same condition we found it in.

Our 2nd meeting is planned for Saturday afternoon, Dec. 5th from 1pm to 3pm at the [Town of Oyster Bay Indoor Ice Skating Rink](#). I have been there several times and have NEVER seen it crowded. (Can't promise it will stay this way, but it is an amazing new location...the rink is huge, and sometimes there are only 3 people on it!). This will be a pay as you go event. Admission/food will be your own responsibility on that day.

Our 3rd meeting is scheduled for Sat. Feb. 6th at 6:30 pm at the Calvary Lutheran Church in East Meadow. This meeting will celebrate the Chinese New Year. It will be a Dumpling Making Party, and we ask that your child/ren bring one friend from outside our adoption community. We want to share our adoptive community and it's culture with their friends. More info will follow on this as we get closer.
