About Our Program

Since 1999, this group of dedicated adoptive families has gathered on Saturdays to help encourage an appreciation of Chinese Language, Heritage and Dance and Culture for their adopted, (and biological) children.

The program is unique in that it is geared specifically for the needs of our community of families - families who do not speak Mandarin at home, nor have extensive knowledge of Chinese culture and language. Another distinctive feature exclusive to our meetings is that children and their parents attend and participate together. As a result, our program fosters an environment that also functions as a support group for both parents and children alike.

Language skills are quickly acquired through songs, dance and games, and then as children gain experience, we progress to character recognition, reading, and writing. Stroke order is soon understood through an innovative approach of cutting and piecing together characters; a technique developed by our mentor, Ms. Man-Li Lin (which has since been implemented in programs and schools across the US and in China.)

Our program also provides an exposure to many cultural elements as well. Among these are Tai Chi, Shaolin Kung Fu and various styles of traditional dance. Our families are occasionally exposed to a variety of Chinese foods, and traditions not often found on Long Island. We encourage a positive connection to the Flushing Chinese-American Community and schedule seasonal visits to the many cultural opportunities available in the area. In short, our program provides a very unique and important opportunity for enrichment for our very unique and important families.

Man-Li, our instructor, friend and a self professed "forever learner" has graciously led our program lessons since its founding in 1999. She has a BA in Chinese Literature from National Taiwan University, MS in Management Engineering and MS in Teaching English as Second Language from Long Island University, C.W. Post Campus. She is the first Asian Business Development Specialist at the U.S. Small Business Administration. She served as a board member of East Coast Association of Chinese Schools, Long Island Institute of Technology, NY State board of Acupuncture, and Queens Council on the Arts. She conducted Chinese teacher training when she was the chair of NY Chinese School Association, and is the author of "Chinese 214 Radicals", "Chinese Textbook for Adults I, II, and III", "Chinese Textbook for Children I, II, and III", and "Resume Writing and Interview Skills". In addition, she has taught ESL and Chinese in various programs across the country for more than twenty years. Her devotion to FCC families began in 1997 when she first began teaching our adoptive families at Hastings High School in Westchester. Man-Li's passion for our children, and her willingness to act as a bridge between two worlds of diverse culture, history, arts and language are evidenced in the countless programs that she continues to dedicate herself to, throughout Queens and Long Island. Her generous spirit, innovative instruction methods, and diverse ability to teach both language and traditional dance, as well as her enthusiasm to share her many musical and artistic talents with our families is to give the gift of exposure to Chinese culture in a forum unlike any other. The ripple effects of each droplet we glean from her will resonate with our children throughout their lifetime, and for that we are grateful.
